Acute Comprehensive

This project was a complete renovation of the entire third floor of the Halsted building at The Johns Hopkins Hospital and a partial renovation of the adjoining Osler 3 space. The project created a new long-term recovery area for rehab patients. Dining facilities, treatment areas, physical therapy rooms, new nurses' station, patient rooms and staff/support areas were constructed.

The project scope included selective demolition, drywall, floor leveling, new finishes for floors, walls and ceilings, a new nurse call system, architectural millwork, electrical, mechanical and fire protection.

This 12,000 SF renovation was valued at \$1,100,000.
