Excellent coordination between contractor and owner allowed the entire main emergency department at the Johns Hopkins Hospital to be completely renovated while functioning at full capacity at all times. Scheduling and phasing were critical to the success of this project which included the creation of an acute care area, treatment rooms, a new nurses' station and a renovated triage area.

The scope of work included selective demolition, drywall, architectural millwork, aluminum partitions, new doors, new finishes for walls, floors and ceilings as well as major alterations to the mechanical, electrical and fire protection systems.

The contract value for this 9,200 SF project was \$887,000.
